AN ACT to amend "The New Zealand Company's Land Claimants Act, 1892." Title.
[29th September, 1894.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The New Zealand Company's Land Claimants Act 1892 Amendment Act, 1894." Short Title.

2. Section six of "The New Zealand Company's Land Claimants Act, 1892" (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), is hereby amended by striking out the word "ninety-four," in the fourth line thereof, and inserting in place thereof the word "ninety-six," and the said Act shall be read as if such words had been originally inserted in the said section. Extension of time.

3. To enable the Commissioner to give effect to the said Act and this Act, section six of "The Land Orders and Scrip Act, 1858," is hereby re-enacted, and shall have full force and effect until the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.
