Title 1. Short Title 2. Meaning of "Commonwealth representative"

1963, No. 106

An Act to amend the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957 [23 October 1963]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Oaths and Declarations Amendment Act 1963, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Meaning of "Commonwealth representative"—Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in the definition of the term "Commonwealth representative", after the words "Consular Officer", the word "Pro-consul".

This Act is administered in the Department of Justice.
