Title	2. Occupier of orchard to pay levy
1. Short Title	

1976, No. 111

An Act to amend the Orchard Levy Act 1953

[9 December 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Orchard Levy Amendment Act 1976, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Orchard Levy Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Occupier of orchard to pay levy—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 3 (as substituted by section 2 of the Orchard Levy Amendment Act 1969), and substituting the following section:

“3. (1) Every person who on the 31st day of January in any year is the occupier of an orchard shall pay to the Federation in the month of March in that year a levy at such rate not exceeding \$40 as the Minister, having regard to the recommendation of the Federation, may from time to time specify by notice in the *Gazette*.

“(2) For the purposes of this section, 2 or more orchards of which the same person is the occupier shall be deemed to constitute a single orchard.”

(2) The following enactments are hereby consequentially repealed:

- (a) The Orchard Levy Amendment Act 1969:
- (b) Section 3 of the Orchard Levy Amendment Act 1972.

This Act is administered in the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
