Title.

An Act to amend "The Opium Prohibition Act, 1901."

[24th September, 1906.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Opium Prohibition Act Amendment Act, 1906"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Opium Prohibition Act, 1901" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

Retailers of opium to keep book.

- 2. (1.) Every person who purchases opium from the holder of a permit shall from time to time enter or cause to be entered in a book kept for that purpose the like entries and particulars as are prescribed by section four of the principal Act in the case of the holder of the permit.
- (2.) Sections four and five of the principal Act shall, mutatis mutandis, extend and apply to every such person.
