**An Act to amend the Quantity Surveyors Act 1968**

[13 December 1979]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Quantity Surveyors Amendment Act 1979, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quantity Surveyors Act 1968 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Interpretation**—Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the definitions of the terms “Building Surveyors Institute” and “Institute”, and substituting the following definition:

“ ‘Institute’ means the New Zealand Institute of Quantity Surveyors Incorporated:”.

**3. Consequential amendments**—(1) Section 3 (2) of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the word “Three”, and substituting the word “Five”;
- (b) By repealing paragraph (e).

(2) Section 16 (1) of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words “, the Institute, and the Building Surveyors Institute”, and substituting the words “and the Institute”.

(3) Section 25 (1) of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words “and to the Building Surveyors Institute”.

(4) Section 26 (7) of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words “, the Institute, and the Building Surveyors Institute”, and substituting the words “and the Institute”.

(5) Section 27 (2) of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words “or by the Building Surveyors Institute, shall be appointed by the Institute or the Building Surveyors Institute, as the case may be, or, where both Institutes have appealed, shall be appointed by both Institutes acting jointly”, and substituting the words “shall be appointed by the Institute”.

(6) Section 27 (5) of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words “or the Building Surveyors Institute”.
