An Act to amend the Quantity Surveyors Act 1968

[12 December 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Quantity Surveyors Amendment Act 1983, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quantity Surveyors Act 1968 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Quantity Surveyors Investigation Committee—Section 9 (2) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words “Minister on the nomination of the”.

3. Deferment of decisions on applications—(1) Section 14 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

“(4) After considering any application, the Board may defer making a decision on it for any period not exceeding 12 months.”

(2) Section 15 (1) of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “refuse”, the words “, or defer making a decision on,”.

(3) Section 15 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

“(3) If the Board refuses, or defers making a decision on, an application it shall give the applicant written reasons for the refusal or deferral.”

This Act is administered in the Ministry of Works and Development.
