**An Act to amend the Rehabilitation Act 1941**

[24 October 1957]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1957, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rehabilitation Act 1941.

**2. Extending duration of powers to assist servicemen's widows**—(1) Section four of the Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1947 (as amended by the Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1955) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight", and substituting the words "thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty".

(2) The Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1955 is hereby consequentially repealed.
