An Act to amend the Rehabilitation Act 1941 [24 October 1957]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1957, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rehabilitation Act 1941.
- 2. Extending duration of powers to assist servicemen's widows—(1) Section four of the Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1947 (as amended by the Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1955) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight", and substituting the words "thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty".
- (2) The Rehabilitation Amendment Act 1955 is hereby consequentially repealed.
