An Act to amend the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952

[7 May 1991

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- (2) This Act shall come into force on the 15th day of May 1991.
- 2. Constitution of Council—Section 7 (2) of the principal Act (as enacted by section 5 of the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1987) is hereby amended by repealing paragraphs (c) to (f), and substituting the following paragraphs:

"(c) One member to represent masters and officers of ships:

"(d) One member to represent marine engineers:

"(e) One member to represent seamen:

- "(f) One member to represent persons who in their capacity as cooks or stewards are engaged to work on ships."
- **3. Repeal**—Section 89 of the principal Act is hereby repealed.

4. Revocations—The Shipping (Engagement of Seamen) Regulations 1975 (S.R. 1975/69) and the Shipping (Engagement of Seamen) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 1 (S.R. 1975/89) are hereby revoked.

This Act is administered in the Ministry of Transport.
