An Act to amend the Supply Regulations Act 1947. 5 December 1951

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Regulations

2. The supply regulations specified in the Schedule

to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by the

Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall

continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-two, and shall then expire. 3. Section nine of the principal Act is hereby

amended by repealing subsection one (as substituted

by section four of the Supply Regulations Amendment

Act 1950), and substituting the following subsection: "(1) This Act shall continue in force until the.
