A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT declaring that Part of Otago Harbour known as Anderson's Bay to be a Public Domain. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Anderson's Bay Domain Act, 1910. Short Title.

2. That part of the Otago Harbour known as Anderson's Bay, being all that part separated from the main harbour by that portion of the Portobello Beach Road extending between the Township of Craighleith and the Township of Sunshine, is hereby declared to be subject to Part II of the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908. Anderson's Bay declared a public domain.

3. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of the Harbours Act, 1908. Act deemed to be a special Act.
