- 5 WHEREAS by section twenty-seven of the Agriculture Preamble.
(Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, it is provided with
respect to regulations made under the authority of that
section that they shall be laid before Parliament and
shall expire on the close of the last day of the session
10 in which they are so laid before Parliament except so
far as they are expressly validated or confirmed by an
Act of Parliament passed during that session: And
whereas the regulations specified in the Schedule to this
Act have been made under the authority of the said
15 section twenty-seven and have been laid before Parlia-
ment during the present session, and it is desired to
validate and confirm those regulations:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Agricultural Emergency Regulations Confirmation Act, 1937. 5

Confirmation of certain regulations.

2. (1) The regulations specified in the Schedule to this Act are hereby declared to be valid and are hereby confirmed as required by section twenty-seven of the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934. 10

(2) The Export Butter-box Pool Regulations, 1937, specified in the said Schedule, shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-six.

SCHEDULE.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE AGRICULTURE (EMERGENCY POWERS) ACT, 1934, AND CONFIRMED BY THIS ACT.

1. The Dairy Board Election Regulations, 1937 (dated the 23rd day of April, 1937, and published in accordance with the Regulations Act, 1936, under serial number 161/1937).

2. The Dairy-produce (Special Milk Products) Regulations, 1937 (dated the 23rd day of April, 1937, and published in accordance with the Regulations Act, 1936, under serial number 171/1937).

5. The Butter Marketing Regulations, 1937 (dated the 11th day of October, 1937, and published in accordance with the Regulations Act, 1936, under serial number 252/1937).
