This Public Bill originated in the House of Representatives, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to authorise the Raising of Money in Aid of certain Title. Public Works and Purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Aid to Public Works Short Title. and Land Settlement Act, 1904."

2. This Act shall be deemed to be an authorising Act within the "New Zealand 10 meaning of "The New Zealand Loans Act, 1904," and the moneys Loans Act, 1904," applied. hereinafter authorised to be raised shall be raised under and subject to the provisions of that Act accordingly.

3. The Colonial Treasurer is hereby empowered to raise, on the Colonial Treasurer security of and charged upon the public revenues of New Zealand, may raise \$\frac{\text{may raise}}{\pi750,000}\$. 15 such sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of seven hundred and fifty thousand pounds, as he thinks fit.

4. The sums so raised shall bear interest at such rate (not ex-Rate of interest. ceeding four pounds ten shillings per centum per annum) as the Colonial Treasurer prescribes.

5. All moneys raised under the authority of this Act shall, as Moneys raised to be and when raised, be paid into the Public Account to the credit of the Works Fund, and 20

Public Works Fund, and shall from time to time be applied to the applied for works works and purposes specified in the Schedule hereto in such amounts and purposes in Schedule. as are from time to time appropriated by Parliament: Provided

25 that any of the aforesaid moneys appropriated to specific roads or bridges may from time to time, without further authority or appropriation than this Act, be paid over in whole or in part to the local authority in whose district the works are situate, or under whose control such works are usually performed, upon such terms and 30 conditions as in each case the Minister in charge determines by

agreement with such local authority.
