This Act is the Coroners Act 1988 Amendment Act **2007**.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent. 5

This subpart amends the Coroners Act 1988.
- 23 Retirement of coroners and deputies**
Section 33(1) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”. 10
