## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Criminal Code Act, 1893."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-5 lows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Criminal Code Act short Title. 1893 Amendment Act, 1894 (No. 3)."

2. "The Criminal Code Act, 1893" (herein referred to as "the "Criminal Code Act, said Act"), is hereby amended as follows :----

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the said Act, the Persons convicted of 10 Governor in Council may, upon application made on behalf of capital offence since any person convicted of the crime of murder at any criminal to have right of sittings of the Supreme Court held since the first day of January, appeal. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, by order in writing,

15 direct that a new trial shall take place, at such time and before such Court as he may think proper, and thereupon all proceedings shall be taken and all acts done as if such trial had been directed under the provisions of sections four hundred and seventeen of the said Act.
