Section forty-six of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding to the last line thereof the following words: "Provided that, in cases where the Government valuation of the land granted shall not at the time of paying such fees exceed the sum of five pounds, the grant-fee shall be ten shillings."</p> | <p>Section 46, "Crown Grants Act, 1883," amended.</p> |
| <p>3. Section forty-eight of the principal Act shall not apply to grants issued prior to the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two.</p>  | <p>Section 48 amended.</p>                            |
