A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Crown Grants Act, 1883."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Crown Grants Act  
Amendment Act, 1903." Short Title.

2. (1.) Section fifty - two of "The Crown Grants Act, 1883"  
(authorising the compounding of the custody fees in respect of Crown  
10 grants on payment of an amount not exceeding ten pounds per  
centum of the original sum paid for the land described in the grant),  
is hereby amended by repealing all the words beginning "This  
provision," to the end of the section. Power to compound  
custody fees  
extended.

(2.) The power to deliver Crown grants on payment of a  
15 composition for the custody fees as prescribed by the said section  
is hereby revived.
