A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Dog Registration Act, 1880." Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relating to the registration of dogs : Preamble.

5 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Dog Registration Act 1880 Amendment Act, 1887." Short Title.

10 It shall be deemed to be incorporated with "The Dog Registration Act, 1880" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act").

2. Any Registration Officer appointed under the said Act, or other person duly authorized by any local authority, may from time to time at all reasonable hours enter upon any private land for the purposes of seeing whether there are any unregistered dogs or dogs without collars on such private land, and shall have free right of ingress, egress, and regress into, over, and across such private land for such purpose.
