A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Electoral Act, 1927.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment Act, 1932 (No. 2), and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Act, 1927 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.
- 10 **2.** Section seven of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:— Section 7 of principal Act amended.
- 15 (a) By omitting subsection one.
- (b) By omitting paragraph (a) of subsection two.
- (c) By omitting from paragraph (b) in the first and second lines the words "with the addition aforesaid".
- (d) By omitting from paragraph (d) in the fourth line the words "after making the addition aforesaid".
- 20 **3.** Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the second proviso to that section. Section 8 of principal Act amended.
