A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Powers of the Egmont National Park Board. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Egmont National Park Act, 1901," and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Egmont National Park Act, 1900" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"). Short Title.

2. (1.) Notwithstanding anything in the principal Act, it shall be lawful for the Board to issue licenses for all or any of the purposes following, that is to say,— Power to issue certain licenses.

- (a.) To cut and remove dead timber only;
- (b.) To win and remove stone or gravel for metalling roads;
- (c.) To construct and use tramways for the removal of any such timber or road-materials.

(2.) The Board may from time to time make by-laws under the principal Act prescribing— By-laws.

- (d.) The form of such licenses;
- (e.) The conditions under which such licenses shall be issued; and
- (f.) The fees payable on any such license.
