A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend and alter the Law relating to Duties on Gold. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Gold Duties Act 1872 Amendment Act, 1876.” Short Title.

2. On and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, in lieu of the duties authorized by the third section of “The Gold Duties Act, 1872,” to be levied and collected, a duty of one shilling and sixpence per ounce shall be levied and collected. What duties may be levied.
