A BILL INTITULED

An Act to abolish Duties on Gold, and for other Purposes.

Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the duties upon gold should be reduced and Preamble. ultimately abolished:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gold Duties Abolition Act, 1882," Short Title. and it shall come into operation on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty three.

2. This Act shall not apply to the mining districts in the North Island until Act not to apply to the local governing bodies therein in receipt of gold revenue shall have expressed to assent of local their consent by resolution, and the Governor in Council shall have authorized governing bodies. the proclamation of such consent in the Gazette.

2. 3. In this Act the term "the said Act" means "The Gold Duties Act, Interpretation. 15 1872," or any Acts amending the same.

3. 4. In lieu of the duties authorized by the said Act to be levied and Export duties on collected, there shall be levied, collected, and paid to Her Majesty, her heirs and successors, at the Customs, previous to exportation from New Zealand, the 20 following duties upon gold, that is to say,—

Upon every ounce troy weight of gold of the fineness of twenty carats and upwards, and so in proportion for any less quantity than one ounce, one shilling; and so in proportion upon every ounce or part of an ounce of gold of a less degree of fineness than twenty carats.

4. 5. The provisions contained in the sections of "The Gold Duties Act, Sections 4 to 12 of 1870," numbered from four to twelve, both inclusive, shall be deemed to be in- "Gold Duties Act, 1870," incorporated. corporated in this Act and read as part hereof.

5. 6. "The Gold Duties Act, 1872," or any Acts amending the same, shall Repeal of "Gold be and be deemed to be repealed upon the coming into operation of the provisions 30 of this Act.

6. 7. On and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and After 1st January, eighty-four, the export duty on gold shall altogether cease.
