A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Reconstitution of the Greymouth Harbour Board. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Greymouth Harbour Board Reconstitution Act, 1937, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Harbours Act, 1923 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act). Short Title.

2. In this Act "the Board" means the Greymouth Harbour Board. Interpretation.

3. (1) On the third Wednesday in May, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, the members of the Board then in office shall be deemed to have vacated their offices. Reconstitution

(2) Thereafter the Board shall consist of nine members of whom—

(a) One shall be appointed by the Governor-General:

(b) Two shall be elected by the electors of the County of Grey: 20

- (c) Two shall be elected by the electors of the Borough of Greymouth:
- (d) One shall be elected by the electors of the County of Inangahua:
- (e) One shall be elected by the electors of the 5
Boroughs of Brunner and Runanga:
- (f) One shall be elected by the electors of that part of the County of Westland situated to the north of the Waiho River; and
- (g) One shall be elected by the electors of the 10
Boroughs of Hokitika, Kumara, and Ross.

Date of first appointment and first elections of members.

4. (1) The first appointment of a member of the Board pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection *two* of the *last preceding* section shall be made to take effect on the third Wednesday in May, nineteen hundred and 15
thirty-eight, and the member so appointed shall be appointed to hold office until the last Wednesday in April in the year nineteen hundred and forty-one.

(2) The first elections of members of the Board pursuant to subsection *two* of the *last preceding* section 20
shall be held on the second Wednesday in May, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight. The members elected at such elections shall come into office on the third Wednesday in May, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, and shall 25
continue to hold office as if they had been elected in accordance with the provisions of the said Act.

(3) Save as hereinbefore provided, the provisions of the said Act shall apply with respect to the Board as if it were mentioned in the First Schedule to that Act.

Consequential amendments.

5. On the reconstitution of the Board in accordance 30
with the foregoing provisions of this Act sections three and four of the Greymouth Harbour Board Act, 1884, shall be deemed to be repealed, and the Second Schedule to the Harbours Act, 1923, shall be deemed to be amended by the omission therefrom of the reference to the Grey- 35
mouth Harbour Board.

Act deemed to be a special Act.

6. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of the said Act.
