## ANALYSIS.

Title. 1. Short Title. Act to be read with "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885," and amendments thereof.

2. Boards may require from local authorities special contributions to defray deficiencies.

Provisions of said Acts to apply to special contributions. Board may ascertain actual or anticipated deficiency, and allocate the amounts payable by the several local authorities.

## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, Title. 1885."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-
