A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Hours of Polling at Parliamentary Elections. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Extension of Hours for Polling at Parliamentary Elections Act, 1884." Short Title.

2. At every election held after the passing of this Act to return a member or members to serve in the House of Representatives in the General Assembly of New Zealand, the poll, if taken, shall commence  
10 at nine o'clock in the forenoon and be kept open until eight o'clock in the afternoon of the same day. Hours of polling at parliamentary elections.
