A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Hours of Polling at Parliamentary Elections. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Extension of Hours for Short Title.

Polling at Parliamentary Elections Act, 1884."

2. At every election held after the passing of this Act to return Hours of polling at a member or members to serve in the House of Representatives in the parliamentary elections. General Assembly of New Zealand, the poll, if taken, shall commence at nine o'clock in the forenoon and be kept open until eight o'clock in the afternoon of the same day.
