A BILL INTITULED

An Act to grant a Pension to Robert Chisenhall Hamerton, Title. Esquire.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Hamerton Pension Act, Short Title. 1891."

2. There shall be paid to Robert Chisenhall Hamerton, of Pension of 10 Wellington, Esquire, lately holding the office of Public Trustee, out £250 per annum of the Consolidated Fund an annual sum of two hundred and fifty Hamerton. pounds, for the term of his natural life, commencing from the twentyseventh day of August in the present year, and payable monthly on the first day of each month in each year; and the first of such pay-15 ments shall commence and be made on the first day of October, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.

3. The provisions of "The Pensions Act, 1884," shall not apply "Pensions Act, to the pension granted by this Act.
