A BILL INTITULED

An Act to abolish the Wellington City and Suburban Title. Highways Board of Control, to repeal certain Enactments making Special Provision for the Construction and Maintenance of the Hutt Road and certain other Roads and Streets situated in or near to the City of Wellington, and to make Provision for Matters incidental thereto.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 10 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hutt Road Act, Short Title. 1939.

Interpretation.

2. In this Act. unless the context otherwise requires,-

"Board" means the Wellington City Suburban Highways Board of Control established under section three of the Wellington City and Suburban Highways Construction and Hutt Road Amendment Act, 1924:

"Council" means the Wellington City Council: "Hutt Road" means the road or street constructed by the Minister of Railways 10 under section four of the Hutt Railway and Road Improvement Act, 1903, and in that Act referred to as the new Hutt Road, as the same is shown on the plan marked S.O. 223/1 to 11, deposited in the office of the Chief 15 Surveyor at Wellington.

PART I.

Abolition of Board, and Incidental Provisions.

Commencement of this Part.

Abolition of Wellington City and Suburban Highways Board of Control.

Hutt Road vested in appropriate authorities as an ordinary road or street. 3. This Part of this Act shall come into force on

the first day of April, nineteen hundred and forty. 4. The Board is hereby abolished.

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5. (1) The portion of the Hutt Road that is situated within the City of Wellington is hereby declared to be vested in fee-simple in the Corporation of the City of Wellington as a street.

(2) The portion of the Hutt Road that is situated within the County of Makara is hereby declared to be vested in the Crown as a road.

(3) The portion of the Hutt Road that is situated within the Borough of Petone is hereby declared to be 30 vested in fee-simple in the Corporation of the Borough? of Petone as a street.

(4) All contracts of the Wellington City Council that relate to advertisements on the Hutt Road and are in existence at the commencement of this Part of 35 this Act shall thereupon—

(a) In so far as they relate to any portion of the Hutt Road that is situated within the County of Makara, become contracts of the Crown; 04 and

(b) In so far as they relate to any portion of the Hutt Road that is situated within the Borough of Petone, become contracts of the Petone Borough Council.

6. (1) The Council shall be kept indemnified by the Crown to Crown from all liability in respect of the loans specified indemnify Wellington in the First Schedule to this Act, being loans raised City Council by the Council under the enactments repealed by this in respect of certain loans, Act.

10 (2) There shall from time to time, without further appropriation than this section, be paid to the Council out of the Main Highways Account such amounts as may be required by the Council to pay the principal and interest, and the sinking-fund charges (if any), in 15 respect of the said loans, and to defray the costs,

charges, and expenses incurred in so doing.

(3) Where upon the maturity of any of the said loans the total sinking fund in respect thereof will not be sufficient to enable the Council to repay the 20 loan and to defray the costs, charges, and expenses incurred in so doing, the amount required to be paid to the Council under the last preceding subsection to enable it to do so may be raised under section fourteen of the New Zealand Loans Act, 1932, as if the securities 1932, No. 23 25 for that loan were securities charged upon the public

revenues of New Zealand and issued under that Act. (4) The Council shall forthwith remove all Sinking Fund Commissioners (other than the Public Trustee) appointed in respect of any of the said loans, and 30 shall appoint the Public Trustee as Sinking Fund

Commissioner in their place.

(5) All unexpended loan-moneys held by the Council at the commencement of this Part of this Act in respect of any of the said loans shall be forthwith 35 paid by the Council to the Public Account to the credit of the Main Highways Account.

7. (1) The enactments specified in the Second Repeal of

(2) No by-laws made by the Council shall apply 40 after the commencement of this Part of this Act with respect to any portion of the Hutt Road that is situated outside the City of Wellington.

PART II.

TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS.

Extending powers of Wellington City Council. 1915, No. 30 9. (1) For the purposes of section six of the Hutt Road Act, 1915, all moneys expended by the Council with the consent of the Board at any time before the commencement of Part I of this Act in providing lighting and a central kerbing or division for the portion of the Hutt Road that is situated within the City of Wellington, and in completing the railway overbridge at Thorndon and the approaches thereto 10 shall be deemed to be part of the expenditure of the Council in maintaining the Hutt Road.

(2) Any expenditure of the Council in maintaining the Hutt Road (including any expenditure incurred in accordance with subsection one of this section) may, 15 with the consent of the Board, be made out of moneys paid to the Council by other local authorities under section seven of the Wellington City and Suburban Highways Construction and Hutt Road Amendment Act, 1924, as contributions in respect of other roads 20 and streets.

The unexpended balance, as at the date of the commencement of Part I of this Act, of the moneys paid to the Council by other local authorities under section six of the Hutt Road Act, 1915, as contributions 25 to the cost of the maintenance of the Hutt Road or under section seven of the Wellington City and Suburban Highways Construction and Hutt Road Amendment Act, 1924, as contributions in respect of other roads and streets shall forthwith after that date 30 be refunded by the Council to those local authorities in such proportions as the Board determines.

Powers of Main Highways Board. 11. All expenditure incurred and all acts done by the Main Highways Board before the commencement of Part I of this Act (whether before or after the passing 35 of this Act) in relation to the portion of the Hutt Road that is situated within the County of Makara shall be deemed to be and to have always been as valid and lawful as if that portion of the Hutt Road had been duly declared to be a main highway and had been 40 duly classified under section four of the Main Highways Amendment Act, 1936, as a State highway.
