An Act to amend the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, Title. 1908.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Industrial Conciliation and short Title. Arbitration Amendment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 10 1908.

2. (1.) The Court of Arbitration is hereby empowered, on appli- Court of Arbitration cation by any of the parties bound by any award in force at the may fix hours for closing of shops and commencement of this Act, to amend that award by fixing the hours factories. for the closing of any shop or factory to which the award relates.

(2.) In any award that may be made after the commencement of 15 this Act the Court may fix the hours of closing of any shop or factory to which the award relates.
