A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

10 1. This Act may be cited as the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1910, and shall form part of and be read together with the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908. Short Title.

15 2. (1.) The Registrar may on the application of an industrial union, made in accordance with a resolution agreed to at a special meeting convened for the purpose, approve of any alteration of the name of the union, and may amend the register accordingly, and issue a new certificate of registration. Amendment of name of union.

(2.) No such alteration shall affect the entity of the industrial union.
