- 15 (1.) Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the Public Account) specified in the First Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole five hundred and fifteen thousand pounds, as set forth in Schedule;
- (2.) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second 20Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, not exceeding in the whole ten thousand pounds : and
 - (3.) Out of the Consolidated Fund, for transfer to the Public Works Fund, any sums not exceeding one hundred thousand pounds.
