A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account and other Accounts to the Service of the Year ending the Thirty-first Day of March, Nineteen hundred and eleven. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Imprest Supply Act, 1910 Short Title.
(No. 6).

2. In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there may be Imprest grants.
issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and eleven,—

(a.) Out of the Public Account any sums of money not exceeding in the whole two hundred and fifty thousand pounds, as set forth in the First Schedule hereto:

(b.) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, not exceeding in the whole seventeen thousand nine hundred pounds:

(c.) Out of the Consolidated Fund, for transfer to the Public Works Fund, any sums not exceeding fifty thousand pounds.

3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the Dominion for the Year ending the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and eleven. To be charged as expressed in future Act.
