A BILL INTITULED

An Act to vest in Trustees certain Land acquired for a Drill-shed Title. at Kaiapoi.

WHEREAS the piece of land at Kaiapoi described in the Schedule Preamble 5 hereto has been acquired for the purposes of a drill-shed for the Volunteers of the district, and a drill-shed erected thereon, and it is expedient for the proper control and maintenance thereof that the said land and building should be vested in trustees: And whereas such land is now vested in Her Majesty the Queen:

Be it therefore enacted by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Kaiapoi Drill-shed Act, Short Title. 1888."
- 2. The land described in the Schedule hereto, and all buildings of the land erections thereon, are hereby vested for an estate in fee-simple in Alexander Lean, Lieutenant-Colonel, commanding the Christchurch District of Volunteers; Caleb Whitefoord, Captain in the Kaiapoi Rifles; and Joseph Lothian Wilson, Lieutenant in the Kaiapoi Rifles, as trustees, to hold the said land and buildings as a drill-shed for the use of the Kaiapoi Volunteers, subject to the provisions of an Act passed or intended to be passed during the present session of the General Assembly in Parliament, and which Act is shortly intituled, "The Volunteer Drill-sheds and Lands Act, 1888."

ALL that portion of Section No. 297, in the Borough of Kaiapoi, Provincial District of Canterbury, containing 2 roods, bounded towards the north-east, 250 links, by Hilton Street, opposite to the junction of Cam and Hilton Streets; and towards the north-west, 200 links; south-west, 250 links; and south-east, 200 links, by Section No. 297.
