A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Legislature Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. This Act may be cited as the Legislature Amendment Act, 1920, and shall form part of and be read together with the Legislature Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

10 2. Sections eighteen *and nineteen* of the principal Act ~~is~~ *are* hereby amended by omitting the words "five hundred and fifty" wherever they occur and substituting the words "~~five thousand one thousand two hundred and fifty.~~"
