A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable the Land-Tax payable for the Year Title.
One thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine to
be Collected for such Year at one Period.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Land-Tax Collection Act, Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything in "The Land-Tax Act, 1878," Land-Tax for 1879
to be collected in
one payment.
the land-tax in and for the year commencing on the first day
of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, shall be
deemed to have been payable in one payment on the first day of
10 October, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, and payment
thereof may be enforced accordingly.

3. All proceedings taken and acts done under the said Act for Proceedings taken

ment deemed valid.
the purpose of collecting or otherwise obtaining payment of the said
tax on the day aforesaid, and all other acts, matters, and things done
15 in connection therewith or in relation thereto shall be deemed to have
been and to be good and valid in law to all intents and purposes what-
soever, and to have been taken and done in strict accordance with
the provisions of the said Act.
