A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to constitute a Public Holiday to be known as Labour Day. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Labour Day Act, 1899." Short Title.
- 2. The second Wednesday in the month of October in each year shall be known as "Labour Day." Labour Day instituted.
- 10 3. Labour Day is hereby declared to be a public holiday. To be a public holiday.
- 4. Subsection one of section sixty-three of "The Factories Act, 1894," is hereby extended to include Labour Day. To be a holiday under "The Factories Act, 1894."
