A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Local Elections Act, 1904.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Elections Act Amendment Act, 1908, and it shall be read together with and as part of the Local Elections Act, 1904, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short Title.

2. The declaration required by subsection three of section thirteen of the principal Act to be made and subscribed before the Returning Officer for the district may, when the residence of the Deputy Returning Officer is situated at a distance of more than five miles from the office of such Returning Officer, be taken and subscribed before any Justice of the Peace for the Dominion of New Zealand.
