A BILL INTITULED An Act to reconstitute the Harbour Board for the Port of Lyttelton. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Lyttelton Harbour Board Act, 1882." 2. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of Incorporation of "The Harbours Act, 1878." "The Harbours Act, 1878," which Act and all Acts amending the same shall be incorporated with this Act. 3. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the context,— Interpretation. "Harbour" means the Harbour of Lyttelton as defined at the time of the 10 coming into operation of this Act, or as it may be defined under "The Harbours Act, 1878," or any Act amending the same: "Board" means the Harbour Board constituted under the provisions of this Act: "The said Act" means "The Harbours Act, 1878," and all Acts amending 15 the same: "Chamber of Commerce" means the present association in the City of Christchurch, known as the Christchurch Chamber of Commerce. 4. A Board is hereby constituted under the said Act for the Harbour of Constitution of 20 Lyttelton, and such Board shall consist of thirteen members, of whom six shall Board. form a quorum. 5. The Board shall be constituted as follows:— Members of Board, how elected. (1.) Two members to be appointed by the Governor; (2.) The Mayor for the time being of the Borough of Lyttelton: (3.) One member to be elected by the ratepayers of the Borough of 25 Lyttelton; (4.) Two members to be elected by the Christchurch Chamber of Commerce from among the members thereof; (5.) Two members to be elected by the ratepayers of the City of Christchurch; 30 No. 98-1.

- (6.) One member to be elected by the ratepayers of the Borough of Sydenham:
- (7.) Two members to be elected by the Council of the County of Selwyn;
- (8.) One member to be elected by the Council of the County of Ashley:
- (9.) One member to be elected by the Council of the County of Ashburton.

Nominated members to hold office for two years. 6. The members of the Board to be appointed by the Governor may be appointed at any time after the coming into operation of this Act, and they shall hold office for a period of two years, to be computed from the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two.

First election.

7. The first election of the elective members shall be held on the first Wednesday in the month of October, one thousand eight hundred and 10 eighty-two, in manner provided by the said Act; and such elections shall be in substitution of the ordinary biennial election required to be held in February next under the said Act.

Elective members to hold office till ensuing election. 8. The elective members of the Board shall come into office on their election, and shall hold office from the time of their election until the biennial election 15 of members of the Board, to be held in February, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five.

Termination of office of existing Board.

9. The now existing Lyttelton Harbour Board shall cease to hold office on the coming into office of the elected members of the Board under this Act.

Repeal.

10. All provisions of any Act which may be repugnant or in contradiction 20 of this Act are hereby repealed.
