A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to limit Distress for Rent.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Limitation of Distress for Rent Act, 1912, and shall form part of and be read together with the Distress and Replevin Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Section five of the Distress and Replevin Act, 1908, is hereby amended by inserting the word "furniture" after the word "bedding" in the first line of the said section; and the words "fifty pounds" are hereby substituted for and shall be read in lieu of the words "twenty-five pounds" where those words occur in the said section.

Exemption of chattels to the value of £50 from distress.

3. Section four of the Distress and Replevin Act, 1908, is hereby repealed.
