A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to validate and confirm certain Regulations Title. made under the Authority of the League of Nations Sanctions (Enforcement in New Zealand) Act, 1935.

- 5 WHEREAS by section seven of the League of Nations Preamble. Sanctions (Enforcement in New Zealand) Act. 1935, it is provided with respect to regulations made under the authority of that Act that they shall be laid before Parliament and shall expire immediately on the expira-
- 10 tion of two months after they have been so laid before Parliament except so far as they are expressly validated or confirmed by an Act of Parliament: And whereas the regulations specified in the Schedule to this Act have been made under the authority of the said Act and
- 15 have been laid before Parliament during the present session, and it is desired to validate and confirm those regulations:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the 20 authority of the same, as follows:---

1. This Act may be cited as the League of Nations Short Title. Sanctions Regulations Confirmation Act, 1936.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS SANCTIONS (ENFORCEMENT IN NEW ZEALAND) ACT, 1935, AND CONFIRMED BY THIS ACT.

1. The League of Nations Sanctions (Financial) Regulations, 1935 (dated the 25th day of October, 1935, and published in the *Gazette* of the same date).
