A BILL INTITULED

**AN ACT to extend the provisions of the** Title.  
**“Militia Act 1862” in reference to**  
**Pensions to Officers of the Civil Service.**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Militia Acts Amend- Short Title.  
ment Act 1864.”

II. Sections 6 and 7 of the Militia Acts Amendment Act 1862” Sections 6 and 7 of  
the Militia Act 1862  
extended to Officers  
of Civil Service.  
shall apply to Officers of the Civil Service of the Colony and shall be deemed to have so applied from the first day of September 1863.

III. Whenever an application shall be made for a Pension under Governor in Council  
to declare relative  
rank of Officer.  
this Act the Governor in Council shall for the purpose of fixing the amount declare the rank of the Officer in respect of whom the application is made to correspond with some rank in the Militia Service and the amount of Pension and Allowances shall be according thereto.
