A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Mining Act, 1898."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1903." Short Title.

2. The word "miner" where used in section nine of "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1902," shall mean and include every 10 workman employed underground in a mine. Interpretation of word "miner."

3. The words "or hereafter" in the first line of section nine, and also subsection three of section nine, of "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1902," are hereby repealed. Repeals.
