## MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT AMENDMENT.

### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT further to amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Municipal Corporations Act Amendment Act, 1890," and it shall be read with and as part of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886." Short Title.

10 2. The Council may from time to time apply any portion of the borough funds to erect, establish, and maintain, or otherwise to aid, athenæums, mechanics' institutes, public libraries, and libraries either wholly or partly supported by private subscriptions, but having a reading-room to which the public are admitted free of charge. Borough Councils may establish athenæums, &c.

15 3. The Council may from time to time make, alter, or repeal by-laws for regulating the times when, and the conditions on which, traction-engines may be allowed to pass along any street or road within the borough, and to impose penalties for the breach of such by-laws. By-laws *re* traction engines.
