Title.
1. Short Title.

2. Authorizing modification of conditions subject to which the Tongariro Timber Company (Limited) is required to construct a certain railway.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend Section Nineteen of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1921-22. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Native Land Claims Adjustment Amendment Act, 1923, and shall be read together with and deemed part of section nineteen of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1921-22 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act). Short Title.

2. Section nineteen of the said Act is hereby amended as follows:—

(a.) By adding to subsection one the following words: "and to have full power and authority to amend or vary the said Order in Council, and to vary or revoke all or any of such terms and conditions and to impose other terms and conditions in lieu thereof": Authorizing modification of conditions subject to which the Tongariro Timber Company (Limited) is required to construct a certain railway.

(b.) By inserting in subsection two, after the words "Order in Council," the words "and by the terms and conditions imposed by any Order in Council amending the same":

(c.) By adding to subsection three the following words: "or by any Order in Council amending the same":

(d.) By omitting from subsection four the words "The said Order in Council," and substituting the words "Every such Order in Council":

(e.) By repealing subsection five, and substituting the following subsection:—

"(5.) Section nineteen of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1915, is hereby amended by omitting from subsection one thereof all the words preceding the words 'no remedies for default'."
