A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to abolish the Postage Rate on Newspapers printed within the Colony. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Newspaper Postage Abolition Bill." Short Title.

2. From and after the coming into operation of this Act no postage shall be levied on newspapers printed within the colony. Abolition of postage on newspapers.

10 3. This Act shall come into operation *fourteen* days after it shall have received the assent of the Governor. Date of Act coming into operation.
