A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Amendment Act, 1910. Short Title.

2. (1.) A worker who, having purchased a dwellinghouse for himself and his family, desires to pay off any existing encumbrances thereon, or who desires to erect a dwellinghouse for himself and his family on land on which the Superintendent might advance money under Part II hereof, may apply to the Superintendent for a loan for that purpose. Extension of principal Act to existing workers' dwellings.

(2.) The application shall be in the prescribed form, and shall be accompanied by a statutory declaration that the applicant is a worker within the meaning of this Act, and that he desires the loan either for the sole purpose of erecting a home for himself and his family or for the purpose of paying off any existing encumbrance thereon.

3. This section is in substitution for subsections one and two, section sixty-one, of the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909, which subsections are hereby accordingly repealed. Repeal.
