A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Pharmacy Act, 1880."

Title.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to whether persons holding certificates or diplomas of competency as pharmaceutical chemists or as
5 chemists and druggists or homœopathic chemists from the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland are entitled to be registered as pharmaceutical chemists under "The Pharmacy Act, 1880" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), without being subjected to examination; and it is expedient to remove such doubts:

Preamble.

10 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Pharmacy Act 1880" Amendment Act, 1887." Short Title.

15 2. Subsection three of section nineteen of the said Act is hereby amended by inserting the words "or of Ireland" after the words "Great Britain" in the said subsection.

Pharmaceutical chemists registered in Ireland to be qualified in New Zealand.

3. This Act shall be held to have been in force from the time of the coming into operation of the said Act.

This Act to be retrospective.
