## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Queenstown Borough Council to construct or extend Waterworks, and levy a Special Rate therefor. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Queenstown Waterworks Act, 1877." Short Title.

2. If two-thirds of the burgesses of the Borough of Queenstown present to the Council a petition, praying the Council to construct or extend any waterworks, the Council may by special order construct or extend such waterworks, and may make and levy a special rate on the borough not exceeding two shillings in the pound on the rateable value of all rateable property in the borough; such rate shall be an annually recurring rate, and shall be payable at such interval as such special order directs, and shall be levied year by year without further proceeding by the Council until such works are completed. Council of Borough of Queenstown may, upon the petition of two-thirds of burgesses, levy a special rate of 2s. in the pound to construct or extend waterworks.

3. The power to levy a separate rate conferred by section one hundred and eleven of "The Municipal Corporations Waterworks Act, 1876," shall, as regards the Borough of Queenstown, and for the purpose of constructing or extending waterworks therein, be and the same is hereby extended to two shillings in the pound. Council of Borough of Queenstown may, under section 111 of "Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," levy rate not exceeding 2s. in the pound.
