**A BILL INTITULED**

**An Act to amend the Rating Act 1925**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
5 as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Rating Amendment Act 1957, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rating Act 1925 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 10 2. **Amending provisions as to postponement of rates**—Section seventy-five A of the principal Act (as inserted by section five of the Rating Amendment Act 1954) is hereby amended by omitting from subsection one the words “section seventy-nine”, and substituting the words “section seventy-seven”.
- 15 3. **Amending provisions as to sale or letting of abandoned properties**—Section eighty A of the principal Act (as inserted by section six of the Rating Amendment Act 1954) is hereby amended by omitting from subsection eleven the words “section eighty”, and substituting the words “section seventy-nine”.
