A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Rating Act 1925

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Rating
Amendment Act 1960, and shall be read together with and
deemed part of the Rating Act 1925 (hereinafter referred to
as the principal Act).

10 **2. Payment of rates by instalments**—(1) The principal
Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 61, the
following section:

15 “61A. Notwithstanding anything in this Act, the local
authority may, when making a demand for any rates, make
the rates payable by such instalments and on such dates as
it fixes in that behalf. Those rates shall thereupon become
due and payable by such instalments and on such dates as
are fixed by the local authority without any further demand
for payment.”
